



# Ames Lake Neighborhood ~ 2016 Service Summary

Ames Lake Neighborhood is a 356 unit affordable housing community on St. Paul's Eastside housing over 900 residents.

## 2016 Services Provided:

- 71 large community building events.
- 113 open computer labs.
- 35 early childhood classes serving 27 children from 17 families.
- 88 K-8th grade youth served through year-round youth development programming.
- 261 information and referral contacts with residents in need.
- 22 Community partnerships maintained.



Ames Lake Summer Camp serves 30 K-5th grade resident youth through fun summer activities like a field trip to Como Zoo.



Thanks to a 5 year partnership with the BCA, 75 resident youth are able to participate in their annual Holiday Party.

## 2016 Highlights:

- Police calls continue to remain low at 137 in 2016 or .38 per unit.
- 94% of residents who attend onsite community building events are satisfied.
- 41% of residents state community events and programs for children are one of the reasons they remain living at Ames Lake Neighborhood.
- 67% of residents state onsite programs have had a positive effect on their families.
